within the European Union-funded project **ENCODE: Unveiling Emotional Dimensions of Politics to Foster European Democracy**. The project aims to understand how emotions in response to social media content shape political opinions and engagement, is led by Professor Jörg Matthes and runs from 2024-2027. The position is advertised to an extent of 30 hours/week (75%) for a period of 27 months (until May 31, 2027), with the position ideally to be filled by March 1, 2025.

Job description

You are part of the ENCODE project, which means:

- You actively collaborate in the area of empirical content, reception and effects research, especially in the area of political communication.
- You aim to publish your research in international highly-ranked journals.
- You aim to present your research at national and international conferences, meetings, and symposia.
- You actively engage in applying for third-party funded projects.
- You will be working on reports, deliverables and support the organizational aspects of the project.
- The signing of a doctoral thesis agreement within 12-18 months of employment is expected.

Requirements

- You have obtained a completed MA / Magister degree in Communication Science or a related discipline.
- You have in-depth knowledge of methods of empirical social research, especially quantitative methods and statistical data analysis.
- You are interested in an international research orientation.
- Excellent computer literacy
- Excellent command of written and spoken English
- Ability to work in teams and distinct organizational skills
