The Advertising & Media Psychology Research Group at the Department of Communication, a subunit of the Faculty of Social Sciences of the University of Vienna, seeks to temporarily fill the position as soon as possible of a

Student Assistant (“studentische/r Mitarbeiter/in”)

to support the research activities of Professor Jörg Matthes (<https://advertisingresearch.univie.ac.at/matthes/>) and his team. Specifically, we look for assistance in an international citizen science project entitled *YouCount*, with partners all across Europe (<https://www.youcountproject.eu/>). The project is about social inclusion of young people. We are seeking support in the qualitative research of the project.

We are looking for students who have already completed their BA studies, and a strong interest in qualitative research (experience with it is a bonus, but no must). The following are the main requirements for a successful application:

- A bachelor degree (in *Communication Science* or a related discipline) is obligatory, enrollment in one of our Master programs is advantageous.
- Strong interest in qualitative interview transcription and coding (we appreciate prior experience with it)
- Strong interest in social inclusion
- Applicants must be fluent in written and spoken English

The successful candidate will be contracted for a **period of three months (starting date: beginning of July)** on a working contract, with a **gross salary of approximately € 770 / month and 14 working hours / week**. The possibility of extending the contract for another six months is given.

Your application should include the following documents:

- Short letter of motivation (maximum of one page)
- CV
- A writing example of a scientific text you wrote, e.g., in a class (maximum of five pages)
